

December Council Notes

- † PASTOR'S REPORT—Finalizing staff annual reviews, budgeting processes, and holiday service planning, new microphones a priority.
- TREASURER'S REPORT—Treasurer Gary Onan: Treasurer's Summary November 2018, special council meeting for annual budget scheduled for 01-08-19 & regular council meeting, special consideration and talking points for council members regarding Pastor Jeff's line items per Gary/John, Thrivent Choice Funding approved for \$200.00 toward Thanksgiving Baskets.
- PROPERTY COMMITTEE/FURNANCE AMOUNT APPROVED—MSC to grant property committee \$4000.00 and request for an additional bid, amount approved will be taken from general fund.
- BANK DEPOSIT DISCUSSION/IMPLEMENTATION OF COUNTING PROCEDURES —Discussion of changing deposit of offerings tabled until new council members are selected. Round table with Dean, Mary, Warren, & Lynette discussing best practice at services when only 1 council member is present.


