It's About Sin!

Calvin Coolidge (known as Silent Cal) was the 30th president of the United States. He was known for the short responses he made to questions from other politicians and the press. About one hundred years ago he attended a worship service at a Congregational Church in Washington, DC. His wife Grace was unable to attend. Upon his return to the White House she asked him about the worship service and the sermon. What did the preacher speak about? Cal gave a one word answer "Sin." And what did the preacher say about Sin?, she asked. He responded: "He was against it."

Well, this Lenten Season we too will intensify our spiritual life by focusing on SIN. And guess what? We are against it! The title of our Lenten Series will be **Seven Deadly Sins-One Gracious God.** Please join us at 7 PM on Wednesdays for our Lenten Worship. We will use the Holden Evening Prayer led by our Choir members. There will not be Soup Suppers, but there will be Imposition of Ashes by Pastor Melba Smith and Communion on Ash Wednesday. There will also be communion on Maundy Thursday (April 14).

The Seven Deadly Sins are not described in any one place in the Bible. Dante described them in his chilling poem entitled "The Divine Comedy" around 1300 AD. They are personal characteristics which lead us away from the loving, merciful embrace of our Lord Jesus. They are Pride, Envy, Anger, Sloth, Lust, Greed, and Gluttony. We will talk about one of these each week.

Our Transition Task Force are the ones who conducted a phone interview of almost every member on our roster this past month. They encouraged you to get online and fill out our questionnaire so that we could get your opinions on how we would describe ourselves as a congregation, and what we are looking for in a new pastor.

We thank you! So far, 84 of you have filled out responses. It would be great to report that over 100 of our Christians cared enough to complete a form!

The next step in our search is the formation of the call committee. The call committee is ideally 6 to 8 people representing the age groups who are active in our church. They will finalize the description of the Ministry Site Profile which the church council plans on signing on Tuesday, March 15. Then, the MSP goes to the Synod office in Chetek, Wisconsin, so they can begin to recommend potential candidates who might be available for call this Spring or Summer.

Do you know of a pastor who might be interested in moving to Ellsworth to become our next pastor? Please tell members of the call committee so that we can explore candidates. We will publicize the names of those on the call committee after the council meets on the 15th.
