# **Special Congregational Meeting**

### **Dear Congregation,**

There will be a special congregational meeting on November 14th to take action on approving proposed changes to our Constitution. A group made up of Darla Moquin, Nancy Johnson, Sharon Schulze, Eric Van Nocker, Peter Carr and Pastor Jeff Smith met a number of times to review our Constitution for possible updates and revisions. After discussing possible revisions, the group recommended making changes that update the Constitution to current practices and make it consistent with our Bylaws and Continuing Resolutions. These recommendations were accepted by the Congregational Council for consideration at the special meeting. If approved at that time, these revisions will be brought forward at our 2022 annual meeting for final approval.

The group also reviewed our Bylaws and Continuing Resolutions. The proposed changes to the Bylaws will also be on the annual meeting agenda for approval. The revisions to the Continuing Resolutions were accepted and approved by the Congregational Council and no further action is needed on them. # **Interim Pastor Update ~ Pastor Charlie Bunk**

The Council voted to accept the Synod's recommendation and take on Pastor Charlie Bunk as our interim pastor. An interim pastor is essentially a long-term substitute pastor who will be with us until we call a new permanent pastor. Charlie is a retired pastor who most recently served a church in South Dakota, has experience as an interim pastor and has done mission work in Africa. He and his wife have recently relocated to rural Stockholm, WI.

His start date will be November 1<sup>st</sup>. While the specific details of our arrangement with him are still being worked out, he will be covering Sunday worship services, be available for pastoral care, supporting children's ministry and confirmation and helping guide us through the process of calling a new pastor. We look forward to welcoming him to his first service with us on November 7<sup>th</sup>.



Pastor Bunk will be working Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Sundays. He will be available to help with Baptisms, funerals, hospital and community visits. Please join us in welcoming Pastor Charlie Bunk, and stop into the church to meet him!
