Welcome to the English Lutheran Church's Confirmation Program! We are so grateful that you are here!

What is confirmation? Confirmation in the Lutheran Church is a public profession of faith prepared for by long and careful instruction. It is also called the affirmation of baptism. Confirmation is a place where young people learn about the promises God has made, why he has made them, and how this impacts our lives today.

Our Confirmation program is a three-year program from 7-9th grade and part of the 10th grade year in which the student will be confirmed. This year, students preparing to receive the sacrament of Confirmation will be gathering on Wednesday evenings (schedule attached) to experience opportunities for prayer, and build relationships with their peers and adults, and to discuss scripture. We have set goals for our students in the confirmation program. Students will learn the following in their time as confirmation students:
