

The Vision for God's Future in Ellsworth

The Gospel lesson for this Sunday, January 30th, includes the first sermon Jesus gave in his home Synagogue in Nazareth. The people were astonished at the power and ease with which Jesus pointed to himself as the fulfillment of God's promise of the Jubilee year of God's favor for Israel. Then Jesus reminded the audience of two times in which God gave miracle-working power though Elijah and Elisha to bring about healing to outsiders from Phoenicia and Syria. This did not go over well with his hometown hearers. In fact, they got so mad they took him outside to throw him off the brow of a hill. Jesus acted the part of a kickoff returner in a football game and 'passed through the midst of them.' The astonishing thing about this Bible story is the vision of Jesus for the future of God's people. He is speaking to the Jews gathered on the Sabbath in Nazareth. At the same time he is reaching beyond them to those who have not yet come to faith and trust in the One True God who calls us all by name.

Our Transition Task Force is meeting this week. We will be dividing up the rostered members of English Lutheran, inviting you to fill out a survey so that we can accurately describe ourselves to candidates who might be considering whether they could envision a future in Ellsworth as our pastor. We know that we cannot just take the survey to worship and ask those attending to fill it out. We need to reach those of you who are also following us through the Facebook worship services we broadcast each Sunday. We are also bold enough to think about those who have not yet joined us, but who might be looking to identify themselves when they meet the pastor and members who invite them to join us for worship and witness in Jesus' name.

We hope to spend February seeking out people to respond to this survey, so that we can complete our papers in early March to be sent to potential candidates in April and May. Pastor Randy Olson of the Northwest Synod of Wisconsin hopes to be able to recommend candidates so that we can invite them to consider a call to English Lutheran during the summer. This is an ambitious schedule. Let us all take the first step to agree to complete the survey this month!
