Greetings,

When I was growing up, our house was sandwiched between two houses that both had elderly people who lived there. On the one side was a widow that I called Mrs. Bewbew (Binsfield) and on the other was Mr. and Mrs. Herburger (Hershberger). All three of them were lovely people. Mrs. Binsfield was a kind lady who rarely sat still and always had a candy dish with lemon drops in it. As I would leave her house for a visit, she would always tell me to have a piece of candy and bring one home for my little sister. I would oblige and take two and as I stepped outside, I'd pop them both in my mouth and say to my sister, "Sorry Beth, she only gave me one." I know, I was a terrible older brother, but Mrs. Binsfield knew what I would do, so she had the candy dish ready when my sister came over to ask for a piece of candy.

On the other side were the Hershbergers and they too were amazing neighbors. Mr. Hershberger loved to do woodworking and would invite me down into his shop to see his latest creations. One year, he made us a magazine basket that was shaped like Rudolph the Rednosed Reindeer, and it even had a red cotton ball for a nose. And we still display it every Christmas in memory of Mr. Herberger.

It has been said that children need at least 3-5 adults, besides their parents, to support them in their lives. The school is one place that they find support, and another is hopefully within our neighborhoods like I was lucky enough to experience, but we seem to be more disconnected from our neighbors than ever. The one other place that we can find great adults is within our churches. And I know that we have a lot of phenomenal people in this church!

Now if you are still reading this, you're probably thinking to yourself, "This sounds like a sales pitch. What is Pastor pitching to us?" And I would say that you are right!!! We are trying to expand the number of adults that support our confirmation students by helping you to get to know them better during the season of Lent. During the season of Lent on Wednesday nights, after the worship service is over, our confirmation students will be having one-on-one mentoring sessions with adults in our congregation, possibly you!

Now don't be scared, these will be fifteen-minute conversations and I will have some questions to help guide your discussion. Each Wednesday night after worship, you will sit down in the sanctuary with your youth and get to know them and they in turn will get to know you! The conversations should last 15 minutes or so and it will be every Wednesday night during Lent. Please say yes if you are asked to be a mentor.



English Lutheran Church Council Minutes



December 19, 2023 at 6:30 p.m.

Present: Pastor Pete, Eric Van Nocker, Melba Smith, Gary Brown, Denise Hager, Greta Larson, Jill Hague and Tammy Rieck, Communications Coordinator.

Opening

- a. The Meeting was called to order by Eric Van Nocker, President.
- b. Our Mission Statement was read aloud by all.
- c. Denise Hager led devotions and Melba shared a thoughtful and inspirational message for the coming year.
- d. The December agenda was revised. The potential land sale was added under old business. Council nomination suggestions were added under new business. Approval of December agenda, as amended - MSC
- e. Approval of the November minutes MSC

Old Business

Gary led the discussion on automatic door openers. He discussed the importance and the various estimates that have been received, the general cost involved, and our talented team of congregation installers. A motion was made to approve the purchase of two automatic doors openers and accessories. The motion contained a spend limit of \$5,000. If the cost were to exceed the approved amount, we asked the team to circle back for approval of additional funds. – MSC Pastor Pete updated the Council on the ongoing search for six wooden, five-foot roundtables. The search for the ideal tables continues.

Eric reported that Piper's bake sale for KS95 Kids was a success. She moved all the bake goods and donated \$850. Eric shared that Piper's impressive efforts on the Bake Sale will be highlighted in the Pierce County Herald.

We received a Market Value Analysis on the empty lots we own adjacent to the Church. A discussion was led to consider having the congregation decide if we should sell the property. Council reviewed our previous discussions (village assessments, dumping on the property, etc.), along with additional realtor opinions and made a motion to have the congregation decide. The potential sale will be reviewed and voted on by the congregation at our annual meeting.

New Business

We confirmed the date for the English Lutheran Church Annual Meeting, January 28, 2024.

Gary Brown gave a preliminary review of the 2024 ELC Budget. Council reviewed the budget, compared 2023 budget/actual, discussed some noted increases (insurance) in addition to areas to review more thoroughly and consider before we approve the budget at our January Council meeting. The Committee Reports are due. Reminders have been sent, reports have been received and we noted how we appreciate all the work our volunteers accomplish.

The Council was asked to provide the Nominating Committee with potential interested Council volunteers. Melba Smith, Gary Brown and Eric Van Nocker complete their four-year term in January. Volunteer reach out to Melba Smith. Melba is the Council Member representative to the Nominating Committee.

Reports

- a. Treasurer's/Finance report provided and discussed. A motion was made to approve the Finance/Treasurer Report. MSC
- b. Pastor Pete submitted a written report, see attached. Pastor shared the importance of communication. Sydney Durfee is leaving us to obtain her Master's Degree. Her last day is December 21. Tammy Rieck is our new Communications Coordinator. Ava Maxwell is our new Finance Administrator. All the best to Sydney and we are looking forward to working with Tammy and Ava in their new roles. The Christmas Pageant and the Pastor Pete hosted breakfast was great holiday cheer and much enjoyed.
- c. Property, previously discussed.
- d. Children, Youth & Family. Kingdom Kids and Sunday School is planned through the year.
- e. Stewardship. Melba Smith leads this Committee.
- f. Endowment Committee. The Endowment Fund has been working with the Memorial and Gifts Committee about moving undesignated Memorial and Gifts funding to the Endowment Fund. This was done once before in 2020 when Memorial and Gifts moved \$2,000 to the Endowment Fund. Committee Chair, Warren Johnson, checked with Memorial and Gifts Committee members and they are in agreement that at this time we could move \$5,000 in undesignated funds from Memorial and Gifts to Endowment. This would go into the Endowment general funds account which gives us the most latitude to support Endowment funding requests.
- g. Worship and Music. Our ELC Choir Cantata was awesome. High praise from all who attended. Thank you all for your time and sharing your gift.
- h. Memorial & Gifts.
- i. Nominating Committee. Seeking nominations for 2024-25 Council Members.

Church Council will meet next on January 16, 2024. Council closed the meeting.
