

This is my first greeting to you in this newsletter as the new interim pastor. I am Rev. Charlie Bunk. My wife Barbara and I moved to a home on a bluff overlooking the Mississippi River between Maiden Rock and Stockholm, WI last February.

The church council agreed to hire me as 75% time pastor beginning in November. I will be working in Ellsworth from the church office, and visiting people on Tuesday and Wednesday each week. I will lead worship services and be available for teachings, Baptisms, home visits, and funerals on other days of the week as needed.

I pray God's same blessing for you as the angel Gabriel delivered to Zechariah and Elizabeth that first Christmas, "May you have joy and gladness as you rejoice at his birth!" (Luke 1:11).

Pastor Search Update

The next step in the process of calling a new pastor will be to convene a Transition Task Force. The Task Force will be developing a document called the Ministry Site Profile. This is a description of our community, our congregation and what we are looking for in a new pastor. Our Synod will use the Ministry Site Profile to communicate with pastors who are interested in finding a new church to work at.



Our new interim pastor, Pastor Charlie Bunk, will be assisting the Transition Task Force in the process. Since he will need a little time to get settled in, and then launch right into Advent and Christmas, we have decided to wait until after the 1st of January before getting the Transition Task Force started. A Call Committee will start working once the Ministry Site Profile has been completed.
