

Plus camp is an environment that encourages children and youth to be their true selves and to be welcoming to others.

Other activities at camp include: swimming, Gaga Ball, field games, Bible studies, unique worship services, crafts, archery, gardening, and more! The Superior Hiking Trail is a 310-mile long hiking trail in northeastern Minnesota that follows the rocky ridges overlooking Lake Superior for most of its length. The trail travels through forests of birch, aspen, pine, fir, and cedar.
