Grace & peace dear siblings in Christ!

How are you doing today? It's hard to believe we've been living this "social distancing" way of life for going on seven weeks now! I want to update you on just a couple of things that we as a church are doing in this time.

— We applied for and were approved for the Payroll Protection Program (PPP) through the Small Business Administration. These funds will cover two months of our payroll plus our utility expenses and if used for those purposes, will not have to be paid back. We are grateful that these funds will help us to keep all of our staff on the payroll in the near term and hopefully make up for any lost offering income during the stay-at-home order. I am also grateful for everyone's ongoing financial support in this time allowing our ministry to continue, even if in a different manner than we are used to seeing.

—Council has appointed a special task force, representing the various ministries of our church, to look into best practices for us to resume ministry in our church building when it is safe to do so. This group will be answering questions like:

"How should we do communion?"

"How do we keep households six feet apart in the pews?"

"How do we meet our budget if the fair stand does not happen this year?"

"How do we clean and sanitize DURING Sunday morning services?"

"When do we resume coffee and treat hospitality?"

"How do we can we safely support the needs of the community?"

Know we are working hard every day to figure out how best to do ministry in the midst of a pandemic, how to safely resume in-person ministry as local and federal guidelines allow, and doing what we can to keep our ministry financially stable!

These continue to be stressful times for us all. As this pandemic continues to impact our lives, often in negative ways, please let your church family know if there are ways we might be able to assist you! I'm praying for each of you and I'd like to leave you with the Serenity Prayer, which I came across again in my devotions this week.

God, give us grace to accept with screnity the things that cannot be changed,
Courage to change the things which should be changed,
and the wisdom to distinguish the one from the other.
Living one day at a time, accepting hardship as a pathway to peace,
Taking, as Jesus did, this sinful world as it is, not as I would have it,
Trusting that You will make all things right, if I surrender to Your will,

CHURCH COUNCIL MINUTES & FINANCIAL UPDATE



April Council

- † ELC Covid-19 Response—We will continue to do our best following the guidelines provided to us.
- † A committee consisting of one or two members of the council, and one member from each of the committees- Worship/Music, Youth/Children/Family, Stewardship, Pastor Jeff and Julie Baggenstoss to discuss and form guidelines for returning to in-person worship activities of the church.
- † The Finance Committee has chosen CCF Bank as our new bank for church business- accounts have been set up.
- † The PPP Loan/Grant was approved . There are guidelines to follow that state we may receive as a grant instead of a loan if they are followed.
- † General funds seem to be ok so far.
- † 100th ANNIVERSARY Don't' make permanent plans at this time until restrictions are lifted. We will keep the 100th anniversary on the council agenda for future discussion.
- † Property Committee: The Youth House was discussed. Pastor Jeff stated the property committee does not wish to be responsible for renting it. Pastor reported that the AC needs repair and it needs roofing and siding. Also painting and carpet cleaning. Eric Van Nocker will look into cost of hiring a rental agent. Tearing it down was mentioned.

VBS Canceled

As with many of our events, we will be canceling our Vacation Bible School this summer. Luther Point Bible Camp counselors have led this program for the past couple of years and they have made the decision not to send their counselors out for day camps this year. Also, summer school will not physically meet this year in June, which is where many kids come from for VBS.

For those reasons and the safety of our kids and volunteers we have made the decision to cancel VBS this summer.

Women's Bible Study

Because of the Corona Virus, women's bible study did not meet in April. Nor will we meet in May.

Hopefully, we will be able to resume in September.



Please notify the church office or any deaconess worker with any prayers.



Journey House Campus Ministry, serving students and staff at the University of Wisconsin-River Falls, WI, as well as those at the nearby Chippewa Valley Technical College (CVTC), is conducting a search for a Campus Minister.


Journey House is a welcoming ecumenical ministry jointly supported by the *Evangelical Lutheran Church of American* (ELCA), the *United Methodist Church* (UMC) and the *Presbyterian Church*. Our unique model of ministry involves the Campus Minister providing oversight and doing campus and community outreach in tandem with a team of student Peer Leaders, who attend classes while living at the campus ministry house.

This is a half-time salaried position, with duties and flexible hours closely aligned with the campus academic year and student schedules. The ideal candidate will possess a Bachelor degree or higher, and have skills suitable to building relationships and providing a welcoming ministry to young adults, including those who may be unchurched or of other faiths.


