

Finding a New Pastor

Dear Congregation,

The Congregational Council met with Pastor Randy Olson from the Northwest Synod of Wisconsin at their last meeting. One of his jobs is to help guide congregations through the process of calling a new pastor. His first task is for us is to find a candidate to serve as an interim pastor who will fill in until we call a new pastor. He hopes to have this done by early October. In the meantime, we have substitute pastors scheduled to fill through the month of September.

At the meeting Pastor Olson walked the Council through the overall call process. The first step turns out to be appointing a Transition Task Force. The Task Force will work with our interim pastor to develop a document called the Ministry Site Profile (MSP), which is a description of our church, what we are looking for in a new pastor and a description of our community. The MSP is used to communicate with pastors interested in finding a new church. Once that is completed the Council will appoint a Call Committee whose job will be to screen potential candidates, interview candidates that look promising and make a recommendation on a pastor.


